Lodging:

Marquis de Lafayette Hotel - 501 Beach Avenue 1-800-257-0432

The Marquis Hotel is a six story hotel located on Beach Avenue overlooking Cape May's promenade and the ocean. The totally smoke free hotel is centrally located on the *beachfront* in the Historic District of Cape May. Two short blocks from the Washington Street Mall and four blocks from the Church of the Advent. The rooms are air conditioned, include coffee makers, hairdryers and color cable TV. Refrigerators, microwaves and stovetops are included in the kitchenettes of suite rooms. A majority of the rooms are suites, with two double beds in one room, a bathroom and kitchenette separating the living room with a queen sofa pullout bed, allowing for greater flexibility in the number of people in each room. All rooms are oceanfront including front balconies furnished with rocking chairs. Elevators are located at the end of the building. Each room is assigned one parking space – carpooling is strongly suggested.

All retreat sessions will take place in the dining/conference room of this hotel.

Check the website at <u>www.marquiscapemay.com</u> for a full tour of the facility. Check in time begins at 4:00pm. Late arrivals welcome – please register 6:30 to 7 pm in the dining/conference room for Session One Friday evening. Check out time is 11:00am on Sunday after breakfast.

<u>Victoria Rooms -</u> 2 double beds (sleeps 4). \$165.00 plus 7 % tax per night for up to four people, including breakfast both mornings.

<u>Calculated total weekend hotel pricing per person</u> for two nights stay with the following occupancy is:

Double – two people in room, <u>each person pays \$176.55 for the</u> <u>weekend</u>.

- Triple three people in room, each person pays \$117.70 for the weekend.
- Quad four people in room, each person pays \$88.27 for the weekend.
