- 3. Engage in an increase of stakeholders who have a passion and commitment to eliminate racism
- 4. Work with Communication and event staff for planning of events and workshops

April 25th, THRIVE (North location TBD) focus on Stewardship and Eliminating Institutional Racism, Leadership Day.
