Do you know military service veterans? Do you have families of active duty service persons in your congregation? According to a CNN report, 22 veterans suicide every day. And that is only the beginning. We don't know yet the numbers on how many family members of service people suicide or attempt to suicide. We have "military" families in our congregations. Many may be struggling and you probably don't know it. (For more information on the numbers, see below.)

Two major factors that block people from getting the help they may need appear to be the silence we as a society keep around suicide and the stigma we attach to even considering suicide.
