What is Vocare? Vocare is a Latin word meaning “to call,” and in Isaiah 43:1 (on the cross above) we know that God calls each of us to serve in many different ways. The Vocare program encourages young adults to delve into the lifelong process of discernment of their God-given vocation and calling in their own lives, in the Church, and in the world. Led by young adults, this program usually takes place over a full weekend, so the September 8th event will be an abbreviated “intro” program.
